ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Annual General Meeting (F.Y. 2025–26) of Mahavir International Delhi was held at S.P. Marg Railway Club, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi, under the chairmanship of Shri K. Narayan. 8. Amendments to MOA

Proposed changes to the Memorandum of Association were presented by the Secretary and unanimously adopted.




